Hello Parents/Guardians,

KÉLSET Staff and the Parent Advisory Council (PAC) have partnered up once again to outfit our classrooms with school supplies for the 2020-2021 school year.

For **\$45.00** (grades 1-5), parents and guardians can skip the lines at the stores and instead KÉLSET teachers will organize the supplies to meet the individual needs of their classrooms. **Note**, kindergarten has a slightly different cost and details will have been communicated with families in orientation materials.

What kind of supplies will my child's teacher purchase? Supplies included in this program consist of pencils, duo-tangs, markers, pens, glue, scissors, tape, paper, etc.

Does my child need to bring any supplies to school? Students will still need a pencil box, which may be reused from a previous year.

Is this program mandatory or can I choose to purchase supplies for my child? This program is optional. If you prefer to purchase your own supplies, please see the grade supply list on the KÉLSET School [Website](http://kelset.sd63.bc.ca) (kelset.sd63.bc.ca >> select "Parents" on top drop down then "Forms" to view supply lists by grade).

When and how can I pay the \$45.00? We will begin accepting payment for supplies on Monday, September 14, 2020. Payment can be made either by Cheque or e-transfer. Please include your child's **full name** with payment as those made without a student name will not be accepted.

CHEQUE: Submit to your child's teacher with your child's **full name**.

E-TRANSFER: Submit to KÉLSET PAC (kelsetpacfundraising@gmail.com) with your child's **full name** and use **password:** school supplies (all lower case).

If school supply purchase presents a financial hardship to your family, please inform your child's teacher, Ms. Sinclair-Wise or Ms. Crocket-Moore in September.
