KELSET Family Motto

"A motto is a short sentence or phrase chosen as encapsulating the beliefs or ideals guiding an individual, family, or institution." Your task is to decide on a motto as a family. There are no rules. You may borrow one, use a snippet from song lyrics, take a line from a poem or story, use a list of adjectives, or create something unique. If you use a language other than English, include a translation so we can all learn something new!

As for the picture – you may add a family photo in black and white or colour, have your child(ren) draw a picture of your family, or create a piece of art.

When you return the motto to school, it will be placed outside the classrooms to create a gallery of family mottos. Your creation will be returned after a few weeks so you will have a keepsake. If you have more than one child at KELSET, you may choose to complete just one per family.

All Family Homework should be returned to the classroom teacher by Friday, January 30th. Use the template provided OR your own materials. Glitter is encouraged.
