## **COUGAR SIGHTING:**

- The School has received word from the Sidney RCMP that there has been a confirmed cougar sighting in our area (East Saanich Road.)
- We are providing the following suggestions from the B.C. Environment Safety Guide re: Cougars for your consideration and encourage you to discuss these with your children.

As an effort to ensure there is no conflict between people and cougars the following facts and safety tips are being sent out as a reminder:

- Cougars are most active at dawn and dusk. However, they will roam and hunt at ay time of the day or night in all seasons.
- Encourage children to play outdoors in groups and maintain supervision.
- Bring pets in at night. If they must be left outside ensure they are kenneled.
- Hike in groups of two or more and keep children close-at-hand.

## If you meet a Cougar:

- Never approach.
- Stay calm.
- *Take all children off the ground immediately.*
- Do not run.
- Do not turn your back on the cougar.
- Do all you can to enlarge yourself...pick up sticks and wave them about.

## If a cougar behaves aggressively:

- Wave a large stick, throw rocks, speak loudly.
- Should the cougar attack, FIGHT BACK!

If you should see a cougar contact your local police immediately.
