

Family Literacy Day Homework

Family Literacy Day homework will support the following **KELSET** Beliefs:

- We take care of others by cooperating, helping and being kind
- We take care of others by including and welcoming others
- We take care of our community by supporting those in need

This year, **KELSET** will be celebrating Family Literacy Day by asking each child to create a greeting card *with their family*. The **KELSET CARES** cards will be housed in the library and used for any occasion students see fit.

Expectations for the card:

- Cut the cardstock to fit your envelope.
- **BIG, BRIGHT, AND BEAUTIFUL** using whatever you want (markers, pens, crayons, tissue, photos, pastels, paint, watercolours)
- Positive or inspiring message (you can make it up, use a quote from a book or a person, song lyric, saying in a language other than English (with translation), etc.
- Decorate the **FRONT** of the card only. Leave the inside blank.
- On the back, print **KELSET CARES** and your **family name**
- Have fun! **YOU** decide how much each family contributes to the card.

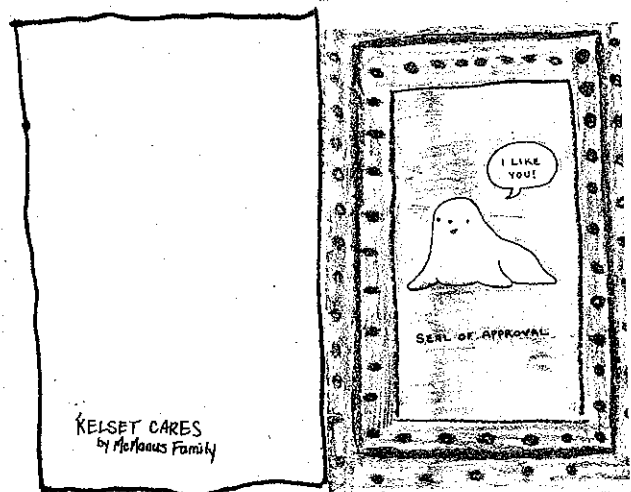
