What is Math Mania?

Math Mania is a popular alternative math education event which has been presented in the elementary schools of Greater Victoria, Saanich and Sooke School Districts since 1997. It is held four or five times a year and is open to all students in the school. Although we welcome all age levels, it is particularly suited to grade one to five students.

Math Mania is free and open to the public. It is sponsored by PIMS (Pacific Institute for the Mathematical Sciences) as part of its education outreach programs.

Math Mania presents a variety of interactive demonstrations, puzzles, games and art such as 'get your goat', the 'penny game', the 'Set Game', the 'Game of 24', 'Tower of Hanoi', kaleidoscopes and straw constructions, and a number of mathematical puzzles and paradoxes. These activities are designed to demonstrate to students - and their parents - fun ways of learning both math and computer science concepts.
