Dear Community Families,

RE: Important update on Beacon's Nature Club program

We're sorry to say we will be not be continuing the Beacon's Nature Club out of school care program past the end of December. We realize this is surprising news and we very much regret any inconvenience or disruption it may cause your family.

We are grateful to the congregation and Minister of Saanich Peninsula Presbyterian Church for opening their doors and hosting Beacon's Nature Club since September. We also recognize and respect the Church must give priority to a variety of its other core activities and it's therefore not feasible to continue our current arrangement. As a result, the program at this site location will close effective December 20, 2019 at 6 pm.

Please be assured we continue to look for appropriate space that will meet licensing requirements and enable us to provide affordable licensed before and after school care for local families. However, at this time we do not have a viable alternate location.

In the meanwhile, Beacon will continue operating before and after school care at Brentwood Elementary. While regular school day programming at Brentwood Elementary is already at capacity, we will also explore offering additional spots at our Winter Break Camp. Families who are registered – or who wish to register – for Winter Break Camp at Brentwood Elementary, please connect with Sheldon Taylor at <u>otterbefuncare@beaconcs.ca</u> ASAP; full day Winter Break programs continue to be available there.

We would also call your attention to Child Care Resource and Referral (<u>www.childcarevictoria.org</u>) and the Province's Find Child Care site (<u>www2.gov.bc.ca/gov/content/family-social-supports/caring-for-young-children/how-to-access-child-care/search-for-child-care</u>), in hopes that these resources may be of assistance.

If you wish, we would also be pleased to keep your contact information and advise you of any new out of school care that may become available at other locations in the future.

We wish your family all the best, and look forward to being able to serve you through other Beacon programs in future.

-	MLA meeting update, Adam Olsen: Marie, Meghan, Brentwood PAC, Keating PAC and Deep Cove PAC – impact and concerns on families, broader picture of education and wider concerns – townhall style in January and ask COPACS to help push this. He asked govt for \$40/child – TBC, but money saved has disappeared out of education into general revenue. So, would be better to divert it to parents instead.	
_	Some parents attended the PAC meeting to discuss issues regarding imminent out-of-school care closure. A round table discussion took place. Families attending feel that childcare is part of education continuum and the provision of this important service needs additional support from school district and admin. Change in class size and composition meant we lost the portable space for the KELSET CARES as no space left to rent. Because its ALR land we apparently cannot add another portable, school can only add to existing footprint. But we could build in the forest area above the car park, is this an option but school may be paying for a building they may not use all the time? Impacts 40 families of the school, 10% of school population. With Beacon Nature Club: only half managed to transfer to this new care after KELSET CARES closed – there is no back-up space anywhere with 6 weeks notice (15Nov letter, closing 20Dec) of out of school care closing. Christina has a spot with Pacific Heart (5 of 20 kids only got lucky), limited spaces, and cost \$260 more/kid/month. Church should have said its not working and ended at end of school year, rather than 6 weeks.  Michelle Squire not present but Meghan Judson gave an update on decisions made from October PAC Closed Meeting regarding funding requests and PAC spending decisions: Update given on closed PAC meeting in October – the PAC decision making process has slightly changed. Previously we had a funding form that should be filled out and given across to the PAC when admin/teachers have a funding request, this form should be reinstated and used consistently again please. The funding requests should be described in the admin portion of the meeting and then in the executive portion of the meeting, the PAC will discuss the requests and vote to review/approve/decline to save feeling pressured to accept all requests and then end up scrambling for funds after the fact. The PAC can then afford to save for our big ticket items e.g., second accessible playground (costs towards \$250,000). It was also discussed with admin that the PAC strongly feels that items they fund should remain with the division and not be teacher owned items e.g., school supplies and rainy day activities. It is not expected that the funds going towards classroom supplies move when a teacher moves from the school, they should stay in the class otherwise we could lose \$4,000 of PAC funded supplies every year that could just walk out the door. This will be communicated to teachers by admin, thank you. In the long run, this new funding request process is more transparent, and more responsible and will serve our kids and school better to give the PAC a chance to discuss funding requests and assess priorities. Improved transparency on school budget would be appreciated to understand funding priorities and requests
