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TREASURER REPORT – Michelle Squire

- Bank balances communicated
- Budget update given from 18 December 2019 meeting (see separate minutes posted to school website).
- School supplies, if everyone spends their \$700 approved (with receipts) we will lose \$2,100. If it stays the current way we will make money – to be determined.
- If we save a little more and do some extra fundraising, we hope we won't be in deficit at end of year but we did have to pass a deficit budget for now.
- SUPERTEACHER worksheet.com website for worksheets is \$358, this will fit into classroom funds
- Propose PAC give school a cheque for \$5,000 for classroom funds then if they want to pay \$358 out of this then go for it. This way we don't have the effort of reconciling classroom costs ourselves and they would need to figure out if one staff needs more then it will have to be balanced with someone else getting less. What happens if they underspend? - we would expect the money back to PAC. Run this past admin for approval.
- Smile Cards Thrifty Payments missing kickback from thrifty's ... Michelle will chase Sobey's for missing payments.
