And have order form at Spring fair too?</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Krista Hale – school supplies</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- In September, we haven’t established a relationship with new students so its difficult to ask for money off new families in the new school year</li> <li>- Could start in June for the following school year and ask for cash, to try and sway people to tick it off early and be more organized</li> <li>- Cathy to talk to District Principal for Indigenous education through Indigenous school board tomorrow (though she is off on mat leave soon) to ask for funding for school supplies for FN students to help next year so PAC isn’t in a deficit.</li> <li>- Krista says likely won’t go below \$700/class as paper books, felts, doodle books, scrap books all cost a lot of money.</li> <li>- 77% people paid for school supplies now.</li> <li>- \$11,950 = \$700 x 19 divisions..... \$8,500 odd paid out currently for supplies but we could pay out to \$14,000, if that’s the case we could be \$3,000+ in deficit ... but Krista thinks max \$500 receipts still coming in and we shouldn’t get to that.</li> <li>- We will give it another go this year and send notices out in May this year, and track who has paid for what.</li> </ul>	<p><b>Epicure: Spring Fair table, also a Mother’s Day fundraiser?</b></p> <p><b>Epicure coordination will go through fundraising</b></p>
